

Largymore Primary School

The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can; sanitise and wash hands as regularly as possible
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic both in school and at home;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean **you will all need to self-isolate for at least 10 days or until the test comes back negative;**
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through Friday Note, text, SEESAW and the school website.

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will book a PCR test & self-isolate for 10 days as a family, I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone or email;
- **You should continue to isolate until the result of the test is available. If the result is positive you should continue to self-isolate for 10 full days after the symptoms started.**
- **You can end self-isolation 10 days after your symptoms started, as long as you do not still have a high temperature. If you still have a high temperature, you need to continue to self-isolate until your temperature has returned to normal for 48 hours.**
- **You do not need to continue self-isolating for more than 10 days if you only have a cough or loss of sense of smell/ taste, as these symptoms can last for several weeks after the infection has gone.**
- If a close contact I will provide proof of a Negative test on Day 8 (result Day 9) before my child returns to school
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- My child will have their temperature taken on arrival and during the day if they feel or present as being unwell
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
- **Read all letters/messages/notices that are sent home;**
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.

Child

I will do my best to:

- Do my morning routine
- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school;
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated door/gate;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (CATCH IT-BIN IT-KILL IT);
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser; or when a member of staff requests it
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
